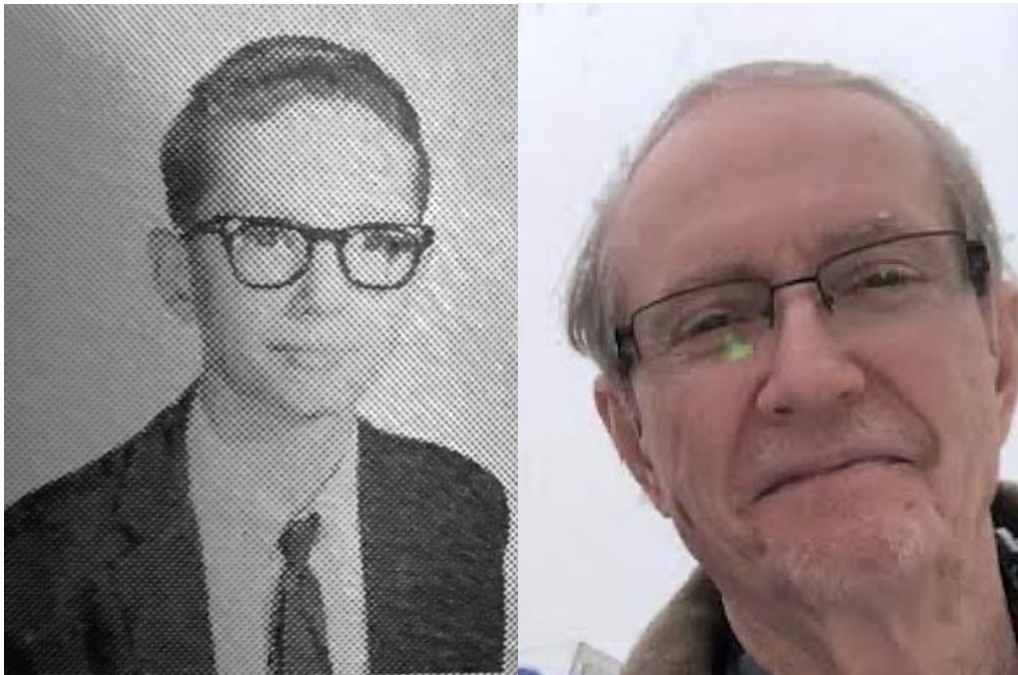




Robert Rewolinski

Robert married Sheri Negriti, and they later divorced. He was the proud father of two deaf sons, Wenzel, who lives in Tucson, Arizona, and Rantz, who lives in Austin, Texas. His sons' late mother was Cathy Teeters.

During his working years, Robert worked for Boeing in Northern California. He later made his home in Wisconsin, where he lived for many years.

Robert will be remembered by his sons, Wenzel and Rantz, and his brother, Vance Rewolinski of Buda, Texas, along with family, friends, and members of the Deaf community whose lives he touched.
