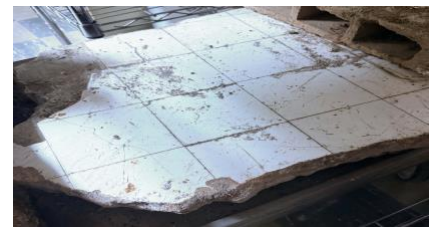
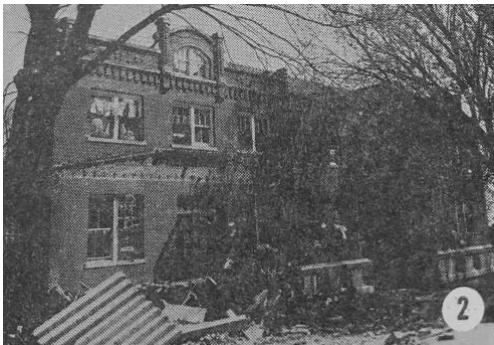

**Bids Let for New \$605,731 Girls' Dormitory;
School Building to be Renovated this Summer**

A contract was awarded this month by the State Board of Education for the construction of the 1968 Building Program at the Nebraska School for the Deaf. The contract is with Charles Vrana and Sons, Omaha general contractor, in the total amount of \$644,800. The work includes the construction of a new Girls' Dormitory, alterations and additions to the School Building and storm drainage structures and underground piping. Vrana's bid was the lowest among 12 bids submitted.

The Girls' Dormitory will be of fireproof concrete and brick construction and will be fully air-conditioned.

The work is to begin immediately with the drainage work scheduled for completion by July 15, 1968; the alterations to the School Building by August 20, 1968, and completion of the Girls' Dormitory by July 15, 1969.
